- **5.** Financial Statement JMC update on the financial statement, bank statement @ 21/07/22 = Current A/C £34,385.28, Saver A/C £118,435.00.
- 6. Matters Arising:
  - Highways Update/Traffic Calming/Speeding/Wynding/Ingram Road AB/BB GRT confirmed little progress. A meeting has been held by AONB, Castle Estates and NCC and parking at Glebe Field and The Wynding discussed. An application has been submitted for seasonal parking at Glebe Field, but NCC were not supportive of a further car park on The Wynding.
  - Bamburgh Conservation Area Character Appraisal AB no further update.
  - Wheelchair Access to Beach KD/BB advised a wheelchair is now successfully being loaned every 3 to four days and the official opening on the 11<sup>th</sup>June went very well. KD and BB attended the Co-op in Seahouses to promote the scheme to members and raise awareness of the ability to choose BANE as a charity.
  - Playpark Update— JM advised to date funding of £122,117.85 received, held by BPC, JM is optimistic that the target needed of £154k, will be raised. Slight design alterations complete and planning application to be submitted.
  - Water Bottle Filler KD/GRT No further updates, will request GRT to continue follow up.
  - **Jubilee Bell AB/KM –** Delay due to engineer holiday and incorrect relay supplied, AB advised delivery expected August, and fitted by end of September.
  - Website Update KM/JM no updates, meeting to be arranged August.
  - Chathill Railway Station AB John Holwell of Seahouses was unable to attend meeting due to holidays, agreed to invite John Holwell to next meeting.
  - Government survey regarding developing a tourist accommodation registration scheme councillors briefly discussed this but felt we had no relevant data but encouraged individuals to respond.
