- 1. Apologies** – Sue Aldred (SA)
- 2. Declaration of interest** – none
- 3. Minutes of 7th May 2025** – Accepted and signed with record revision of wording to “Mill Burn” AB and KM.
- 4. Matters Arising:**
 - **Highways Update/Traffic Calming/Speeding/Wynding/Ingram Road** – AB – No update from Highways regarding planned traffic calming measures. E mail received concerning the additional marking of DYLS on The Wynding, GRT will follow up both issues.
 - **Wheelchair Access to Beach (Beach Access to NE)** – KD – The course of the Mill Burn still an issue.
 - **Play Park** – JM – AB will contact our village warden to instal mesh on perimeter path
 - **Beach Toilet Request** – KM/AB – no further updates and will remove from future agendas until further notice.
- 5. Public Questions** – Email received from resident concerning the path of the Mill Burn causing an issue for wheelchair users, this email to be sent to National Landscapes.
- 6. Financial Statement** – JMC update on the financial statement, bank statement @ 12/06/25 = Current A/C – £528.02, Saver A/C – £40,320.58 (includes £8,935.81 lights fund)
- 7. Glororum to Bamburgh Path** – AB – KM again suggested a short-term measure could be to request that the cutting of both hedge and footpath on route be co-ordinated, GRT will follow up this suggestion. AB to make further contact with Castle Estates.
 - **Other Business** –
 - Northern Powergrid were unable to attend the meeting, GRT advised that a larger area meeting to include Seahouses etc. has been suggested. JMC to respond to Northern Powergrid to arrange.
 - No applications received for position of Parish Councillor, further advertising of the vacancy within the village.
 - Email received from village warden concerning overnight parking at Wynding car park, to be forwarded to Castle Estates.
 - KM advised that issues with EE coverage had been raised on the 9th May to a level 3, anyone experiencing problems should contact EE directly.
